1 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence should be notified to the Clerk by noon on the day of the meeting, if possible. Apologies must be received and accepted before the meeting. If received after the meeting they cannot be recorded.

2 DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

Members to declare any disclosable pecuniary interest or non-pecuniary interest which they have in any item of business on the agenda, the nature of that interest, and in respect of disclosable interests, to leave the meeting prior to the discussion of that item.

Whilst the Clerk can advise on the Code of Conduct and its interpretation, the decision to declare, or not, is the responsibility of the Parish Councillor, based on the particular circumstances.

3 PUBLIC QUESTION TIME (10 MINUTES)

In accordance with the Parish Council's Standing Order No.1, members of the public are able to submit a question, either in writing prior to the meeting, or orally at the meeting, or to make a statement. Please see page 2 of the agenda "Public Speaking Protocol".

Members of the public are reminded that issues concerning pot-holes, road markings, condition of highway, litter etc. should not be raised during this period. Such matters should be reported direct to the Borough Council; alternatively, the Clerk can report on behalf of members of the public and should be contacted outside the meeting.

There should be no discussion on any matter raised by questions or statements. If possible, a response shall be given at the meeting; otherwise a written response will be provided to the questioner.

4 PLANNING APPEAL – MULLER HOMES - APPLICATIONS 12/3746N AND 12/3747N

To consider action to be taken in respect of representation at the Public Inquiry following an appeal made by Muller Homes following the Borough Council's refusal of planning application No. 12/3747N and non-determination of application No. 12/3746N. Members will be able to discuss whether the Parish Council should be represented at the Inquiry and to consider strategy. However, the quotation received from Mr Hindhaugh should be considered under agenda item 6, after the press and public have been excluded from the meeting.
