**3 RE-OPENING THE COMMUNITY HALL OFFICE FOR USE BY POLICE OFFICERS ONLY**

The enclosed letter from PC Marc Harley invites the Parish Council to consider re-opening the Community Hall to enable only the office, to be used by Police Officers. In view of the recent incidences of anti-social behaviour on the Cronkinson estate, this may act as a deterrent to the nuisance being caused.

The letter explains the procedures that will be put in place to ensure that it is a safe environment. This has been sent to Crystal Clean (South Cheshire) to ensure that as the cleaning contractor, the proposals are satisfactory.
