**Rescission of Decision Motion – Community Hall Perimeter Fencing**

(1) Decision to be Rescinded

We the undersigned request that the Parish Council considers rescinding its decision made on 19 October 2015 (Minute No. 90) in accordance with Standing Order No. 10 which requires that at least three parish councillors support the motion.

Decision to be rescinded (Minute No. 90) – Perimeter Fencing

**RESOLVED:** (a) That palisade perimeter fencing, as described in the Clerk's report, be installed at the community hall;

(b) That the contract for installation of the fencing be awarded to Trentham Fencing Ltd in the sum of £7,490 plus VAT, being the lower quotation; and

(c) That it be noted that panic gates in the fencing were excluded on the basis that they were unnecessary as hall patrons exiting through fire doors would move along the passage-way to the fire assembly points.

(2) Summary of Reasons for the Proposed Rescission

The choice of 2m high palisade fencing is considered to be inappropriate and could lead to negative feelings within the community about both the community hall and the Parish Council. Further consideration should be given to installing less severe-looking anti-climb mesh fencing and/or alternative, effective, but less imposing security protection for the vulnerable features of the building.

(3) Alternative Motion

There is no alternative motion at this time. The Parish Council is invited to debate the matter, as given in (2) above. An alternative motion will be moved at the Parish Council meeting following the debate.
