The Police have asked us to remind residents about a few important safety issues.

Lock your sheds and garages!

The Police have asked us to remind residents that burglaries in the area are mostly from unlocked sheds and garages which enables the thieves to steal such items as tools and bikes.

Halloween and Bonfire Night

The Police will be deploying additional resources over the next two weeks to cover the Halloween/Bonfire Night period. If anyone has any concerns, please telephone the Police non-emergency No. which is 101.

Anti-Social Behaviour

Anti-social behaviour is dealt with by the Safer Cheshire East Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) Team at Cheshire East Council (CEC) and not by the Police unless a crime has been committed. If you have any problems please telephone CEC on 0300 123 5030 or you can e-mail safer@cheshireeast.gov.uk.

Anti-Social Behaviour is defined as any aggressive, intimidating or destructive activity that damages or destroys another person's quality of life. In other words behaviour which undermines any person's right to enjoy their home, their neighbourhood and their daily life in peace and safety.

This can include:

- Persistent noise
- Verbal abuse or threats
- Threatening and intimidating behaviour
- Graffiti and damage to the property.
