


Over 500 of our community responded to our recent consultation, which ran until the end of March 2015, sharing their views about the future of our parish. Thank you to everyone who participated.


Here is a summary of the **hottest** topics in each of the five areas of the consultation

Housing

The current large-scale development of 300 houses on the former Stapeley Water Gardens site should be the only large-scale housing development within the Parish during the current term of the Local Plan (until 2030).




Any new houses built in the Parish should include:




Green Spaces, Natural Habitats and Countryside

Green spaces, natural habitats and countryside within the Parish must be preserved.




Existing trees and hedgerows should be preserved and more planted to provide wildlife habitats and diversity in the area




Transport Infrastructure

Cycle ways and footpaths within the Parish should be improved to encourage their use and extend accessibility throughout the parish.




Peak time traffic congestion on Peter de Stapleigh Way and Elwood Way needs to be managed and reduced




Amenities and Well-being

Technological amenities for the Parish need to be improved e.g. 4G; access to super-fast broadband




Amenities and facilities for young people need to be improved




Community

Our community needs to be cleaner (e.g. littering and dog fouling reduced)




Our community is friendly and safe




Who took part?
